### The Story

*John O'Hara*, a mainstay of *Tull* and *Ian Anderson* solo projects since 2003, contributed piano and orchestration to the resigned lament of "*Living in the Night*." *O'Hara's* string arrangement creates a comforting atmosphere which is augmented by *Tim Michling's* oboe and English horn melodies. *Discipline's Matthew Parmenter* provides vocals for this touching yet solemn observation of daily life with dementia.
